
"Our system of culture is founded on printing 1", said French writer Georges Duhamel. Nineteenth century, especially, witnessed an era of the uprising of printing media. Thanks to industrialization of printing press, people could reach text and images in their daily life much easier and frequent than previous time did. On the other hand, a series of changes related to the industrial revolution and its consequences influenced on relationship between men and space: Through exploration and colonization which influenced the representation of space on the globe, an abruptly change of travel experience resulted by the development of new forms of transport, mutation and rapid explosion of urbanization, under all these phenomenon engendered many new types of popular works such as novels and comic strip (bande désinée, BD) that centered movement and the constantly change in space, that is, travel, as their main subject. 

The more information you can provide, such as a class name, student's name, assignment title, paper ID etc, the quicker the process will be.

- 3. Once recovered to the inbox, you can then make a permanent deletion request.
- 4. Nothing will happen to the paper itself until your Turnitin Administrator has approved the request. If Turnitin finds any matches to the paper before the administrator has approved the request, the paper will still show in Similarity Reports.
